

TAP FEE SCHEDULE FOR RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL

| <u>Meter Size (inches)</u> | <u>Water</u> | <u>Sewer</u> |
|----------------------------|--------------|--------------|
| 3/4" | \$2,000 | \$3,250 |
| 1" | \$2,546 | \$3,500 |
| 2" | \$5,360 | \$3,500 |

Any tap greater than 2" will be installed by a qualified contractor and an additional \$1,500 administration review and inspection fee per meter to the Clay County Water & Sewer District will be added to the contractor cost. **All Clay County Water & Sewer District Specifications Must Be Adhered To At All Times During Construction.

**Meter set fees will be charged to all completed contractor projects in addition to the review and inspection fee. Fees are as follows:

3/4" (and all corresponding components) - \$1,500
1" (and all corresponding components) - \$2,000
2" (and all corresponding components) - \$3,500
4" (and all corresponding components) - \$6,200
6" (and all corresponding components) - \$10,000
8" (and all corresponding components) - \$25,000

**Cutting or punching to cross roads, tapping into a force sewer main, making a larger than 2" water and/or sewer tap will be site specific and charges may be added to the above mentioned tap fee schedule.

**All tap fees are to be nonrefundable (unless permits for a new water and/or sewer lines are denied by the state) and are nontransferable from the applicant's original intended use.

**Tap fees are to be collected at the time the service connection is requested and an account security deposit in the amount of \$200 has been paid.

**All boring and easements for crossing adjacent properties and road/highway encroachments are the responsibility of the home/project owner.
